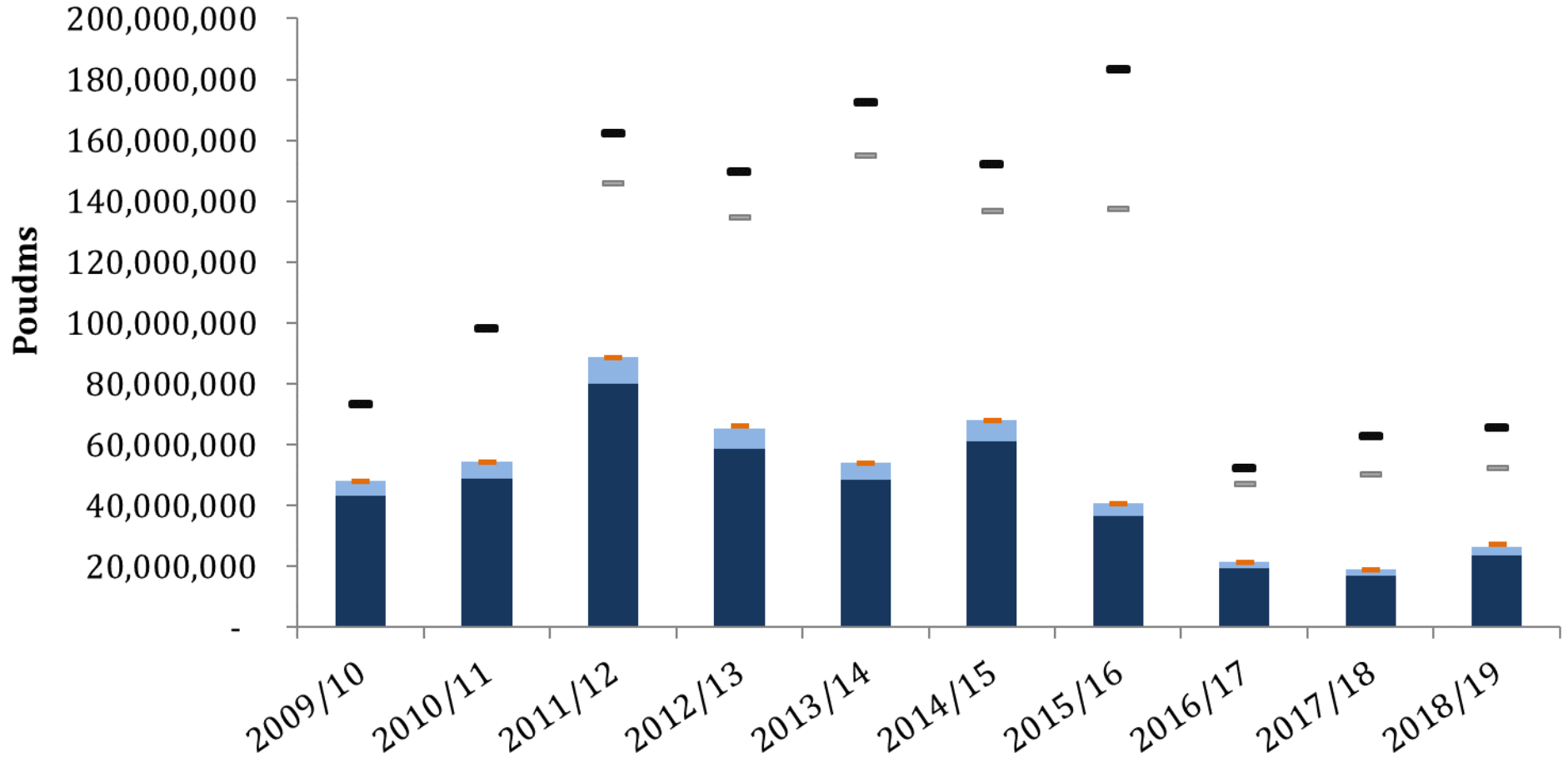

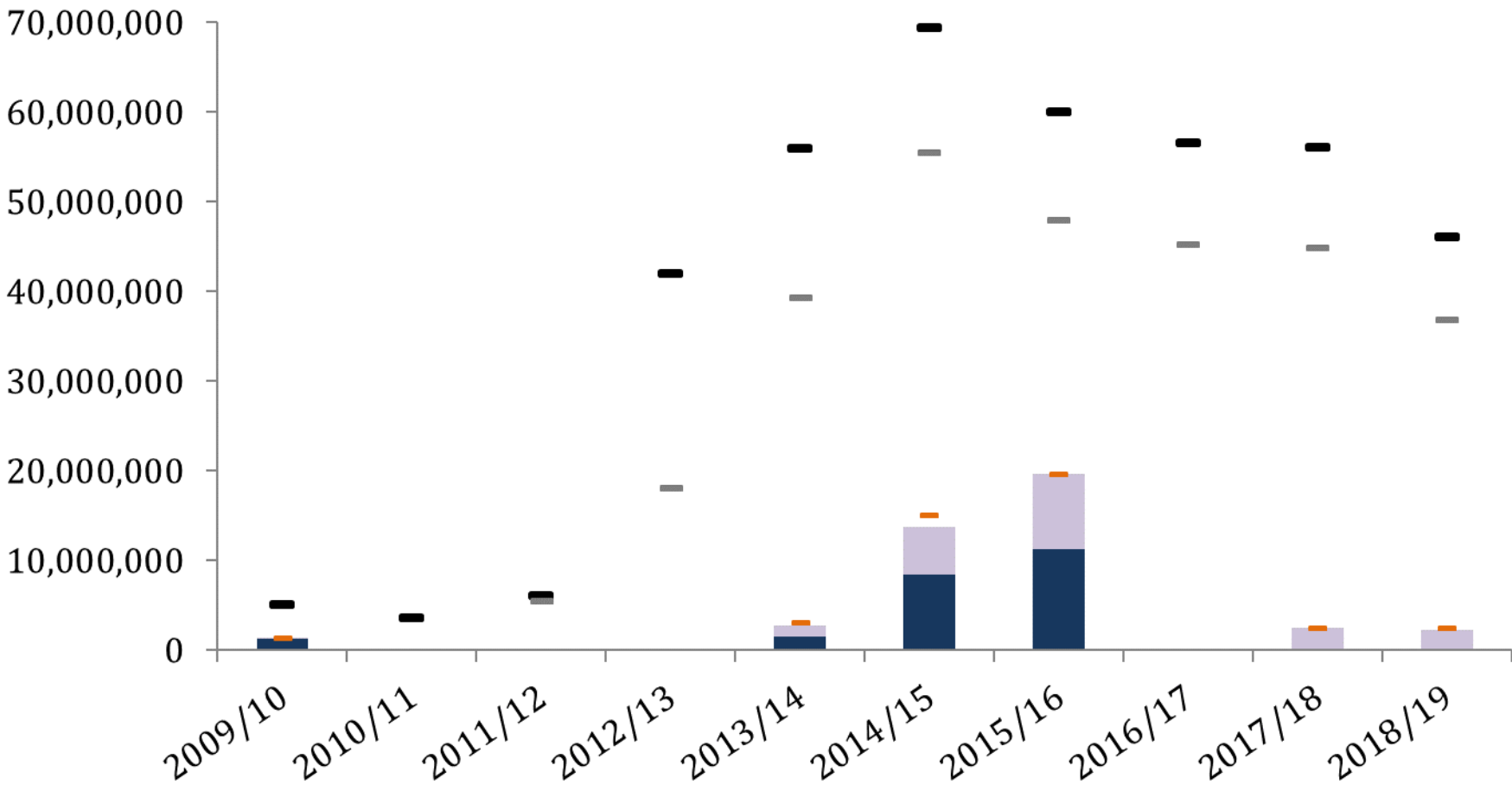

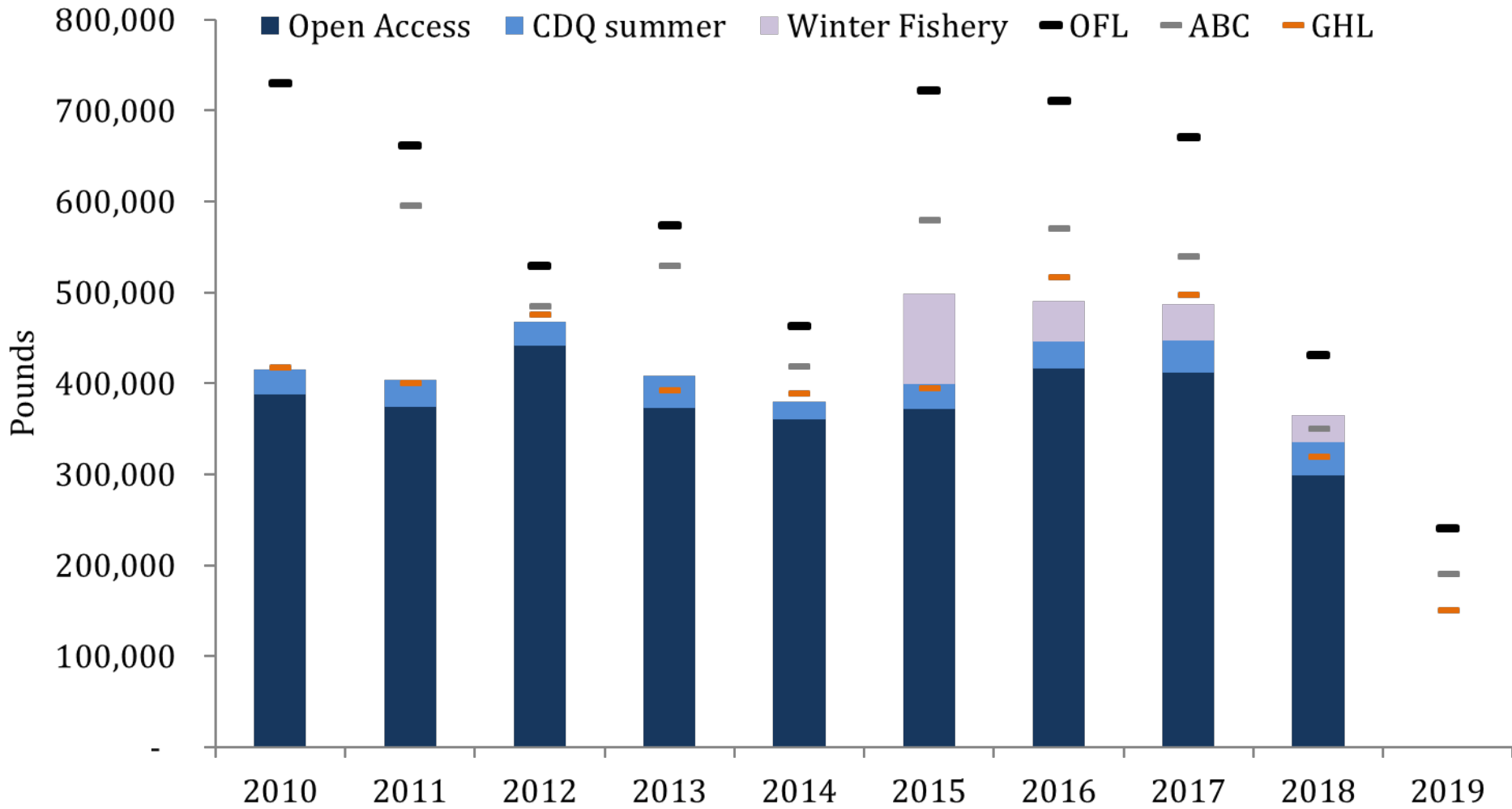


Bering Sea Tanner Crab

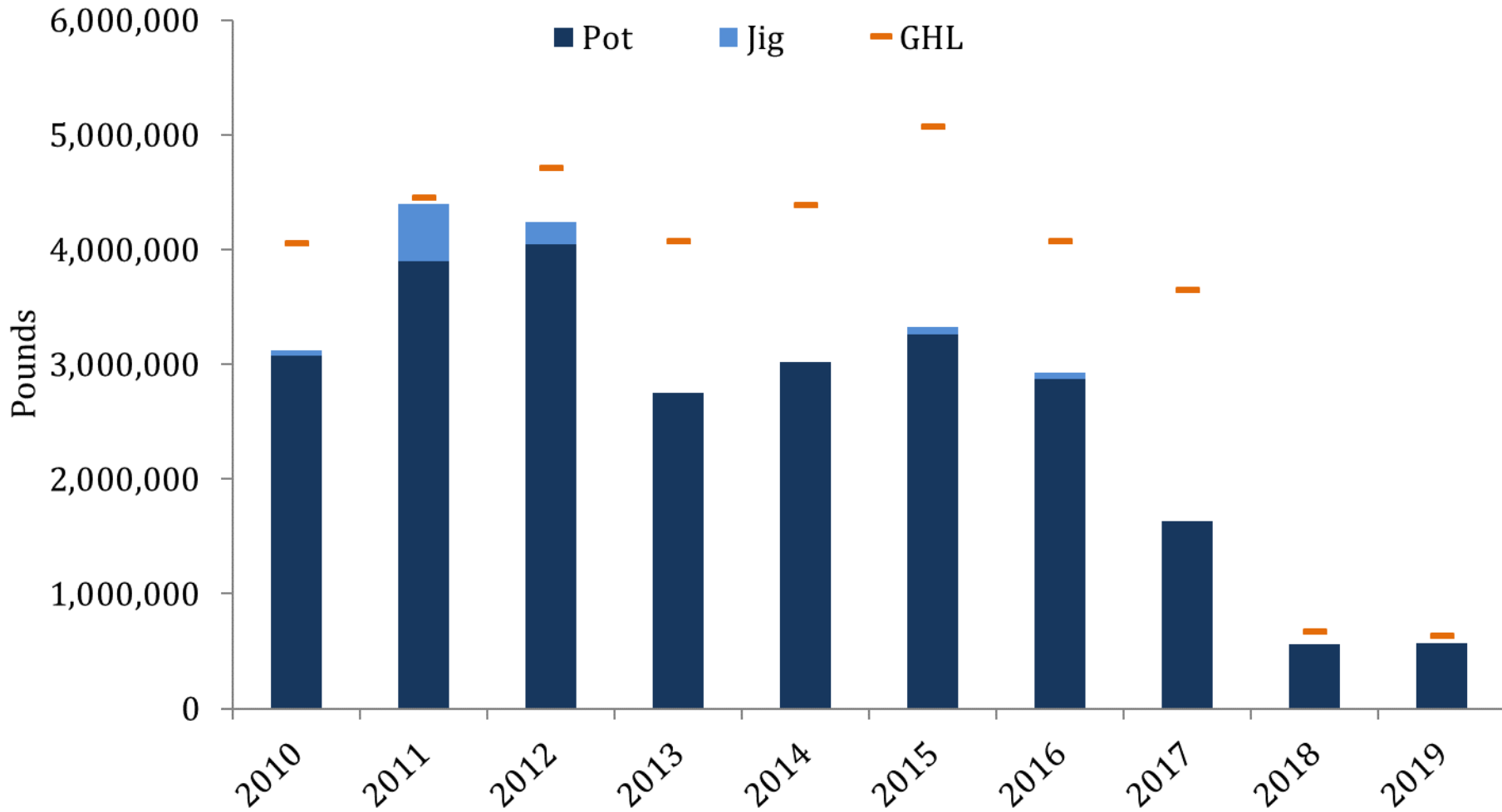
■ Total East Catch ■ Total West Catch — TAC — OFL — ABC



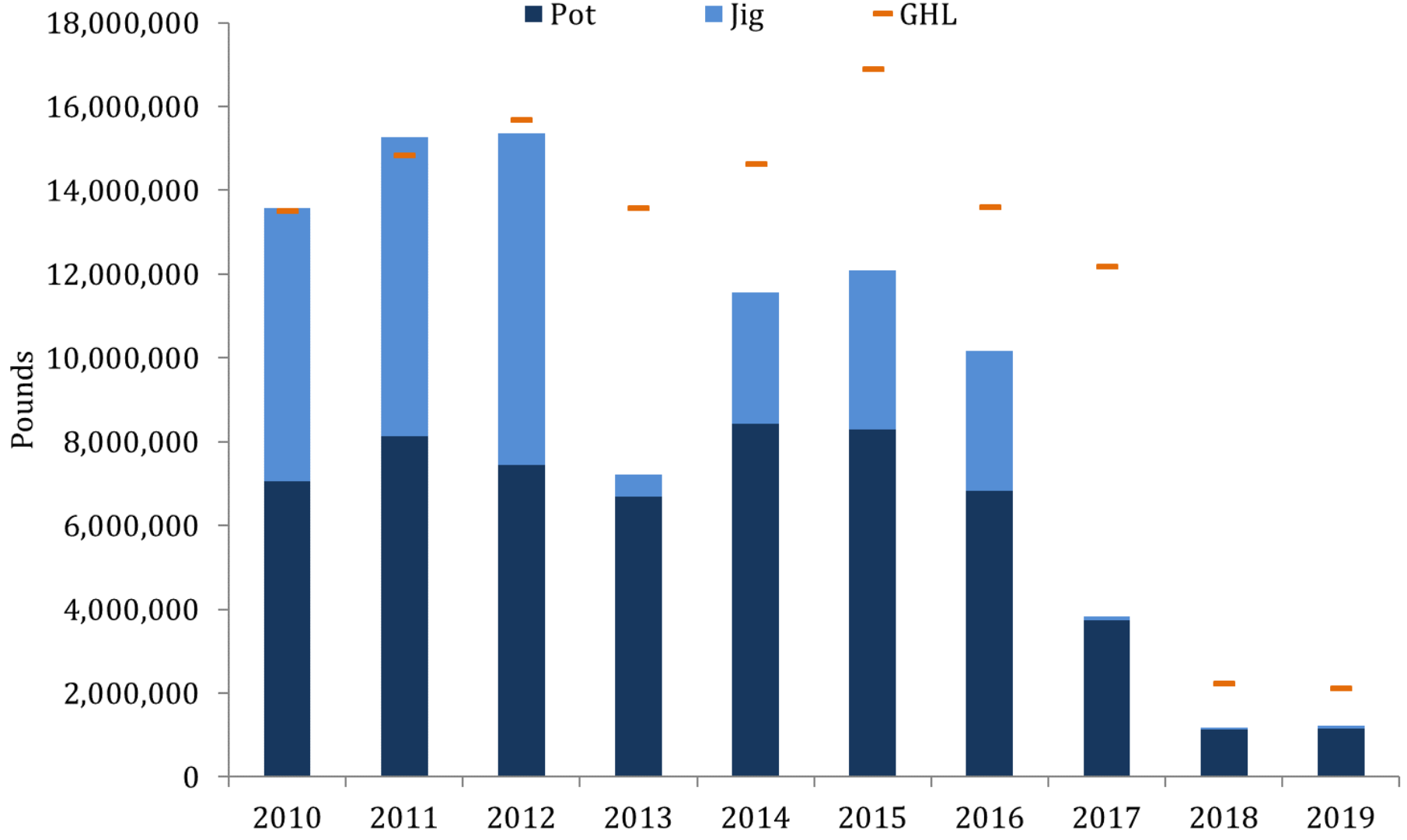
Norton Sound open access, winter and CDQ fishery



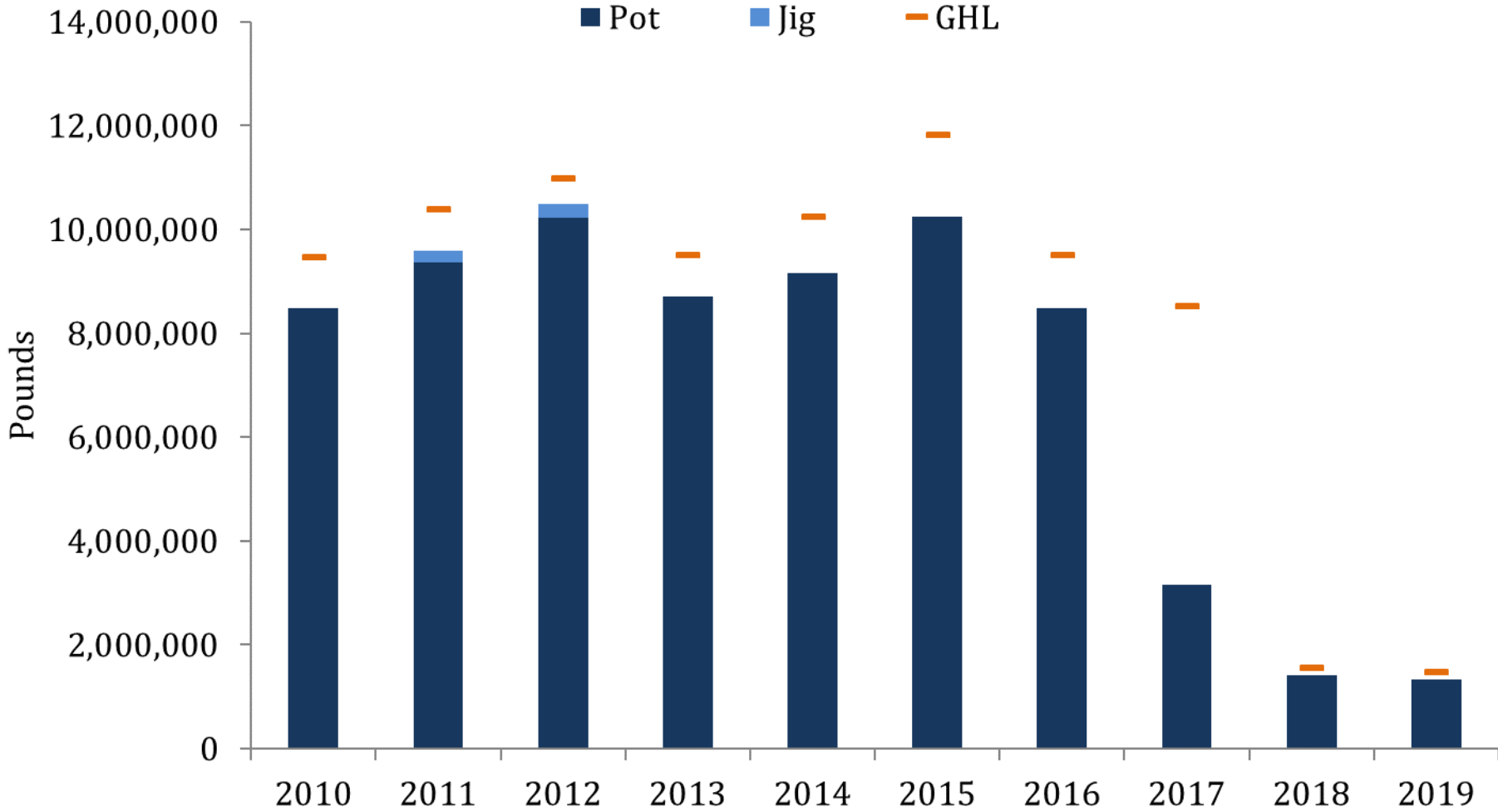
Cook Inlet state-waters Pacific cod



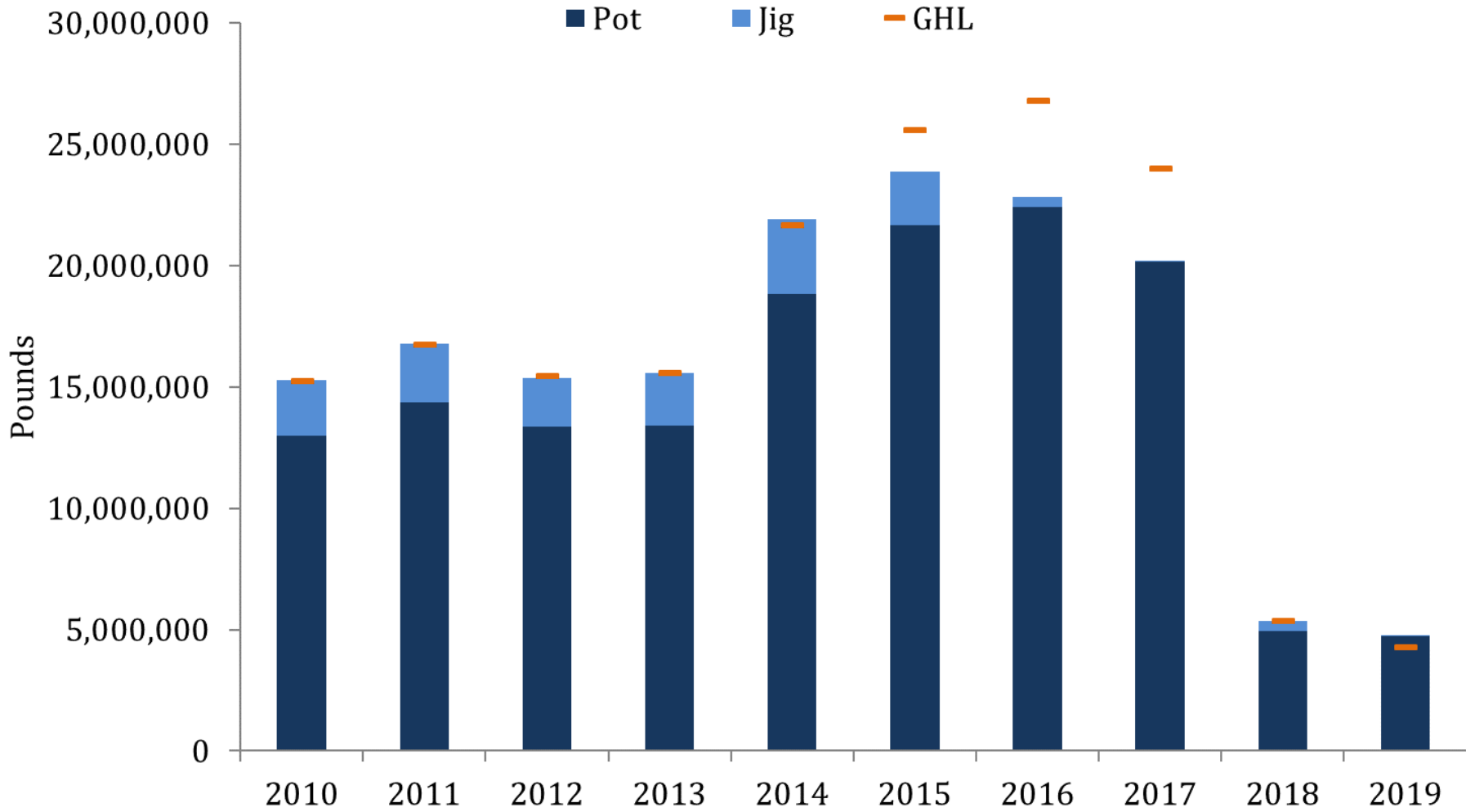
Kodiak state-waters Pacific cod



Chignik state-waters Pacific cod

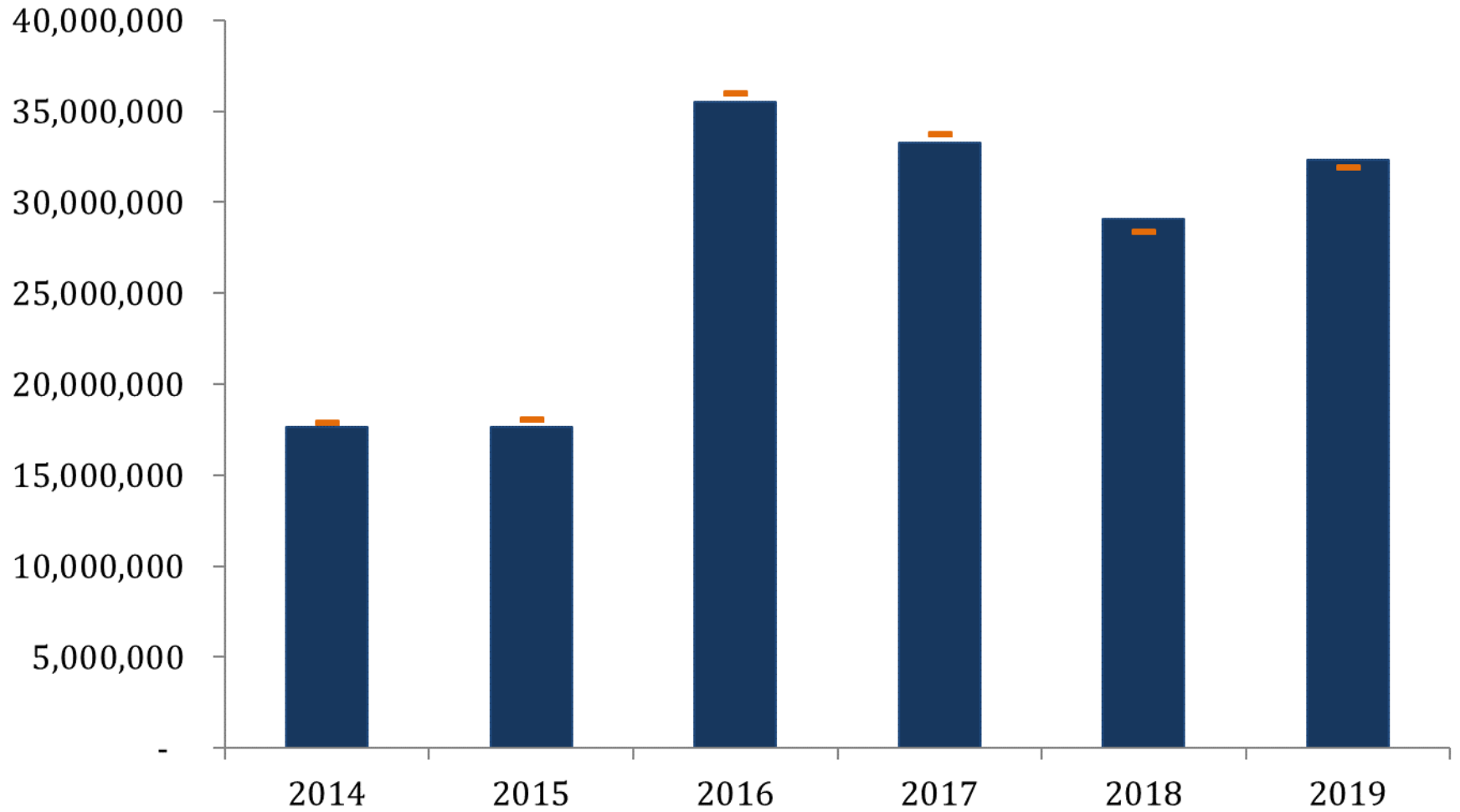


South Alaska Peninsula state waters Pacific cod

Alaska Board of Fisheries

The Alaska Peninsula / Aleutian Island / Chignik finfish meeting was February 21 – 26 in Anchorage.

- Sablefish pots may now be longlined in Western Districts.

Alaska Board of Fisheries

There was a hatchery committee meeting on March 8 and the statewide finfish meeting was March 9-12.

- Adopted the use of the annual assessment the State TAC setting process for AIGKC.
- Allowed for a Tanner crab fishery under the authority of a Commissioners permit for males five and half inches carapace width or greater.
- Beginning January 1, 2020 a person sport fishing from a vessel when releasing a rockfish shall immediately use a deep-water release mechanism to return the fish to the depth it was hooked or to a depth of at least 100 feet.

Alaska Board of Fisheries

The Board is accepting proposals for Lower and Upper Cook Inlet Finfish, Kodiak Finfish, and Statewide (except Southeast and Yakutat) King and Tanner crab until **April 10, 2019**.

The next work session is **October 23 – 24, 2019**.
