However, NMFS does not have a clear authority or responsibility to ensure a level playing field among the full coverage observer providers or guidance about when and how to undertake such a role. As the Council examines the nature of the problems that currently exist with the LL2 observer coverage requirements and alternatives to address these problems, the Council could consider whether, in the future, additional measures should be taken to regulate competition among full coverage observer providers, or prohibit observer providers permitted in the full coverage category from also contracting with NMFS to provide observer services.
